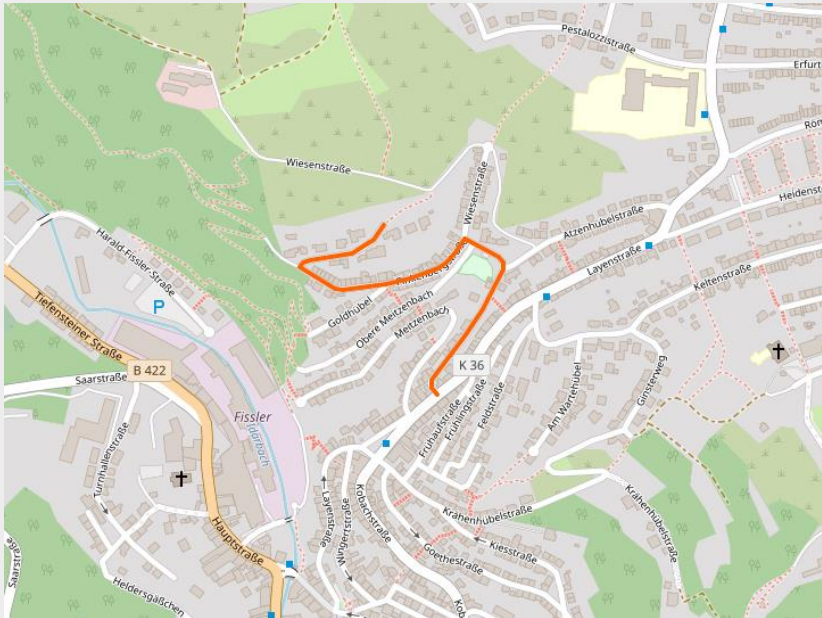




Unter diesem Fundortnamen wird in der Regel ein größeres Gebiet entlang der Finkenbergstraße auf der Ostseite des alten „Idar“ bis nach Wäschertskaulen zusammengefasst. Die besten Funde gelangen bereits in den frühen 1990er Jahren während intensiver Bautätigkeit (z.B. Hotel Kristall). Dementsprechend bestehen aktuell gute Fundchancen nur mehr bei einzelnen Bauprojekten. Auch im kleinen Steinbruch am Finkenberg wurden Achate gefunden („Wolkenachate“). Recht typisch sind größere Sphärolithbildungen und blaugraue Chalcedonbänder im äußeren Bereich der Mandeln, gegen das Zentrum der meist nicht besonders großen, aber wunderbar und oft sehr kontrastreich gezeichneten Mandeln herrschen meist rötliche Bänderungen vor.

A larger area along the Finkenberg street on the east side of the old village of “Idar” up to the Wäschertskaulen area is usually summarized under this site name. The best finds were already made in the early 1990s during intensive construction activity (e.g. Hotel Kristall). As a result, there are currently only good chances of finding agates in individual construction projects. Agates were also found in the small quarry on the Finkenberg (“Cloud agates”). Large spherulites and blue-grey chalcedony bands in the outer area of the nodules are quite typical; reddish bands often predominate towards the center of the usually not too large but wonderfully and often rich in contrast banded agates.

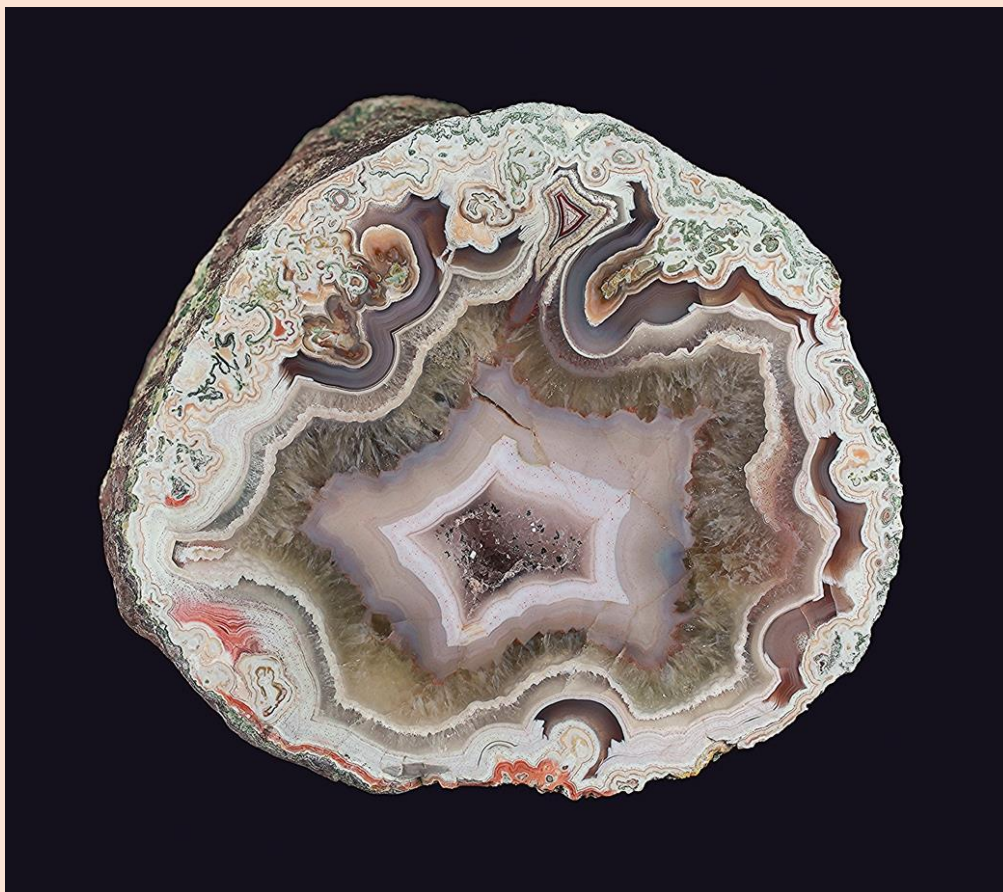

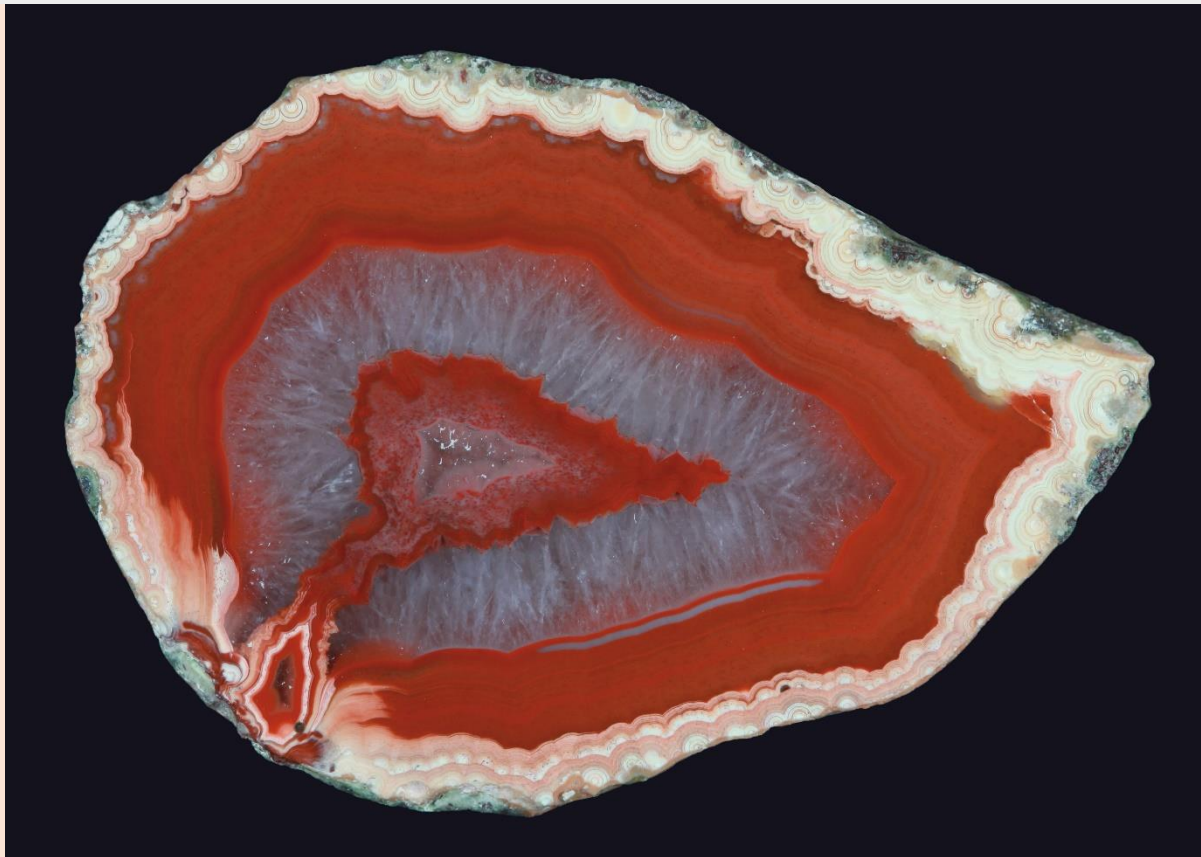

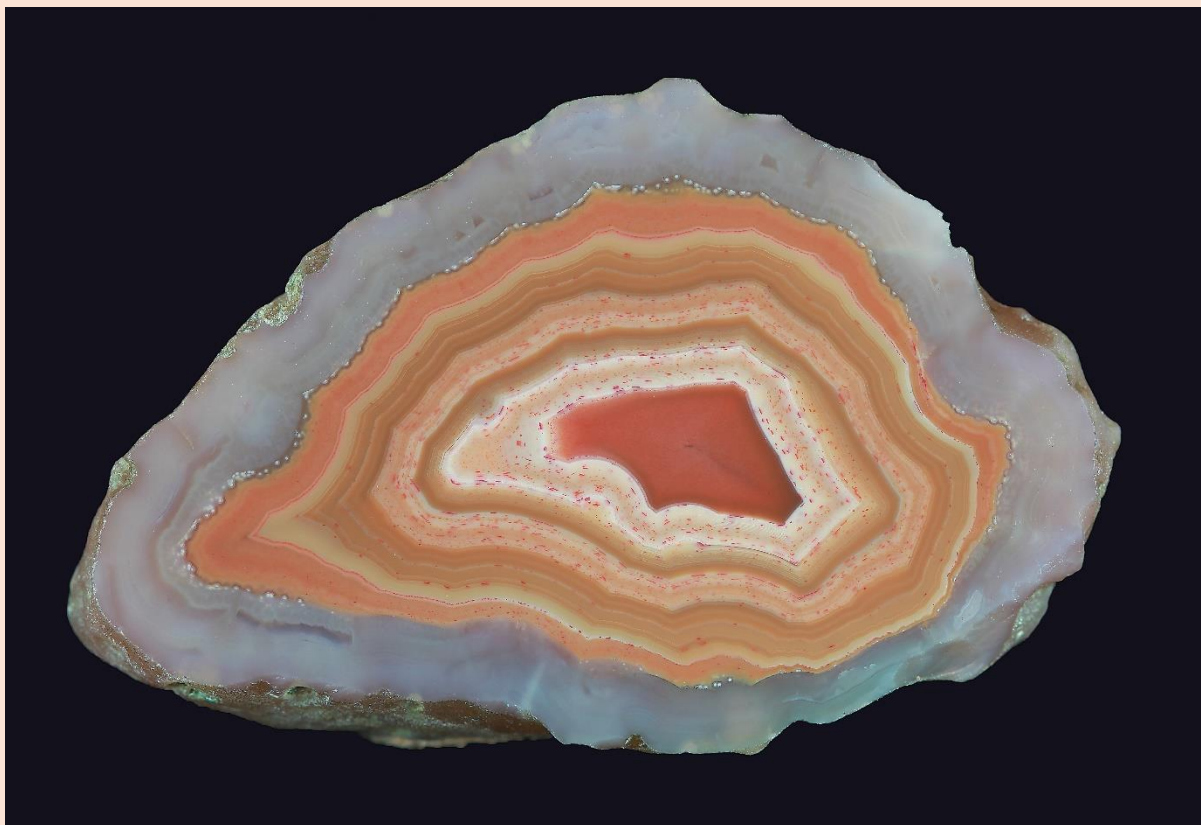

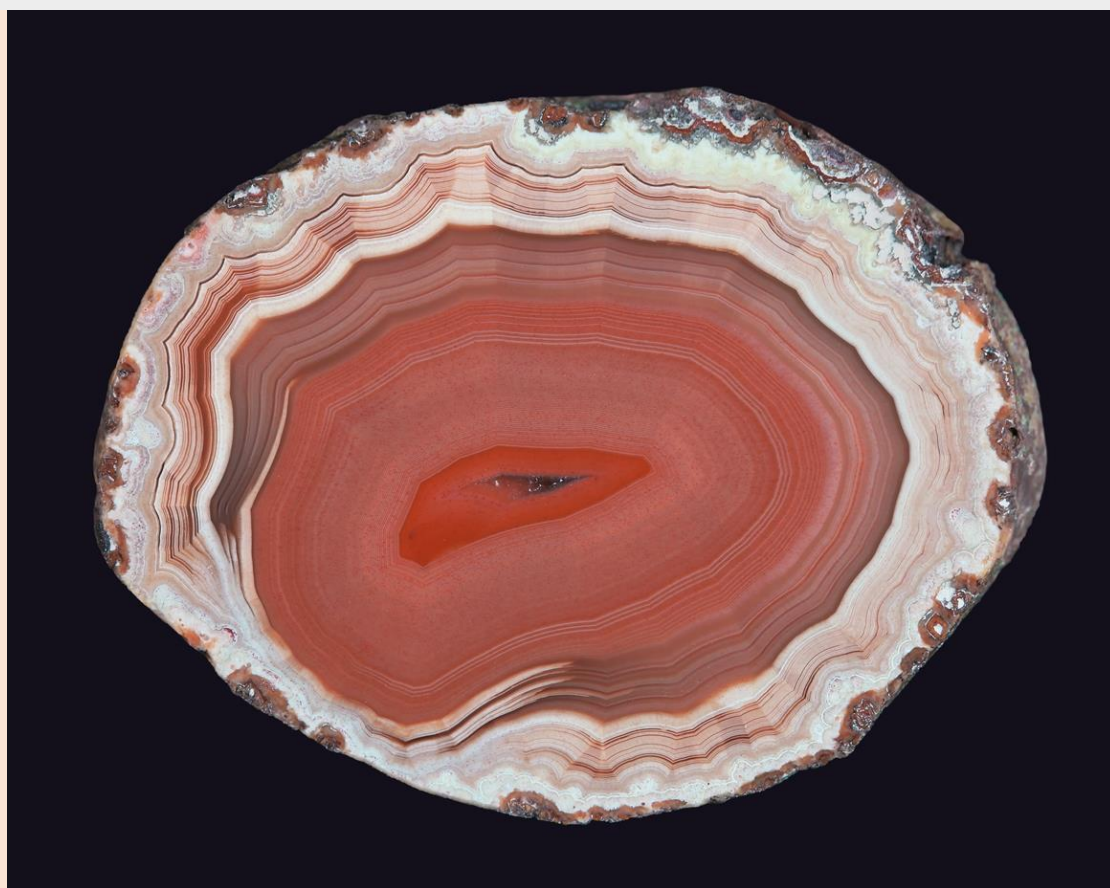

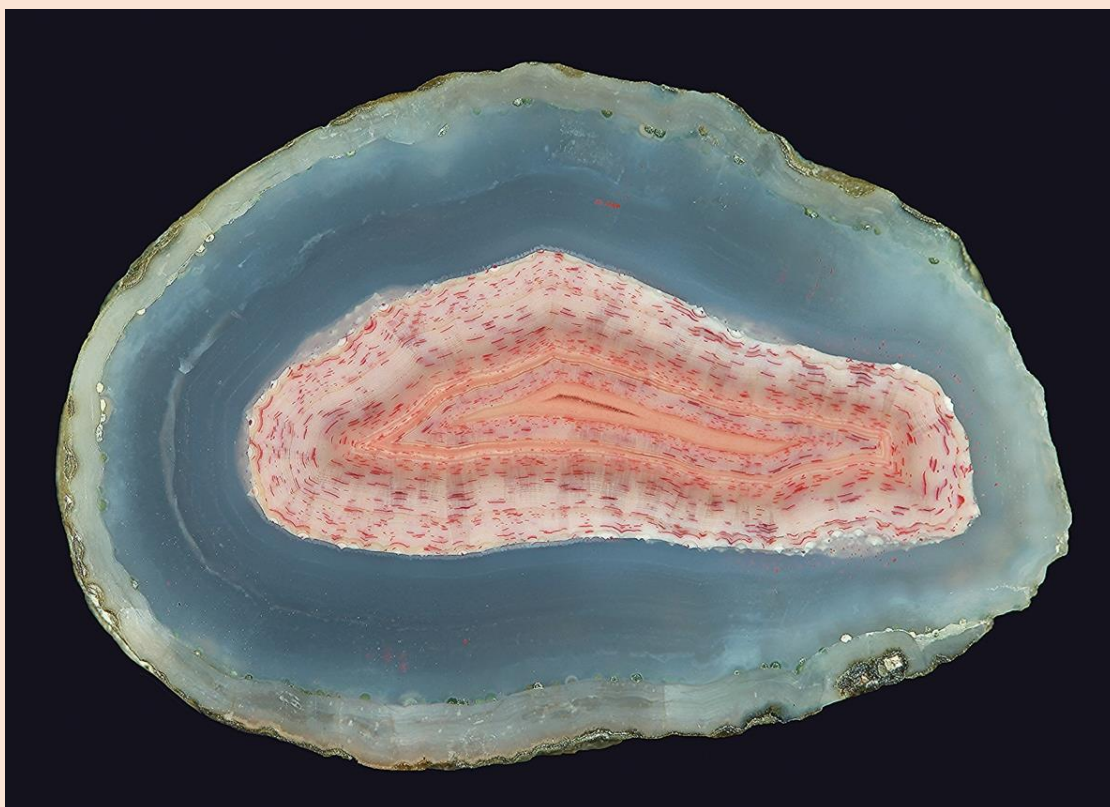

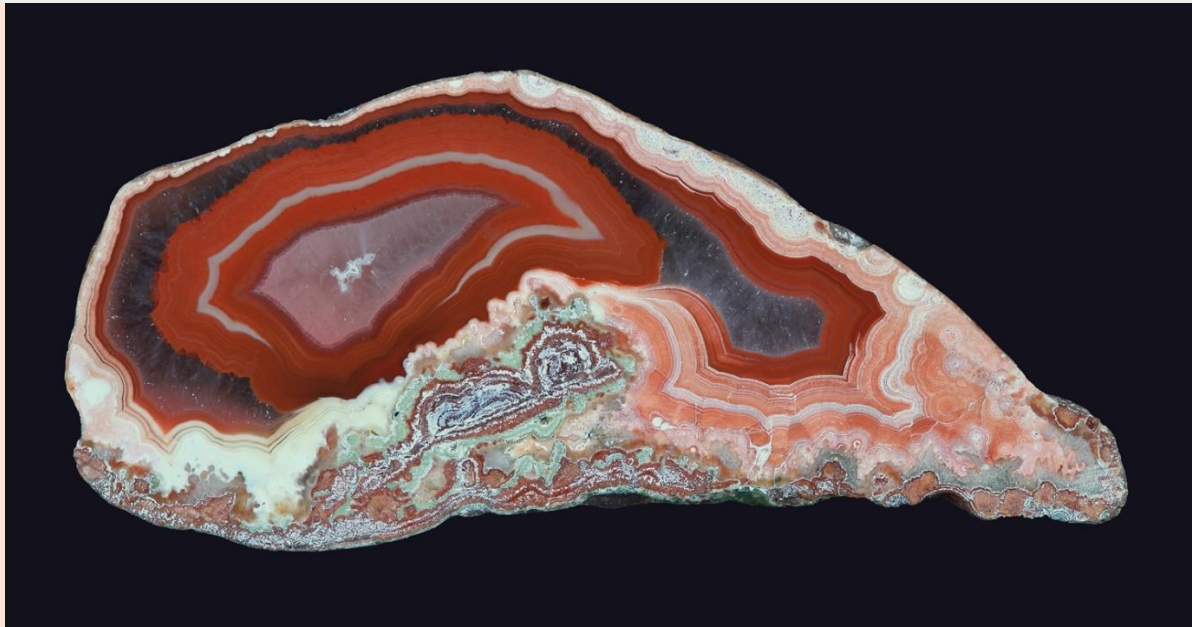

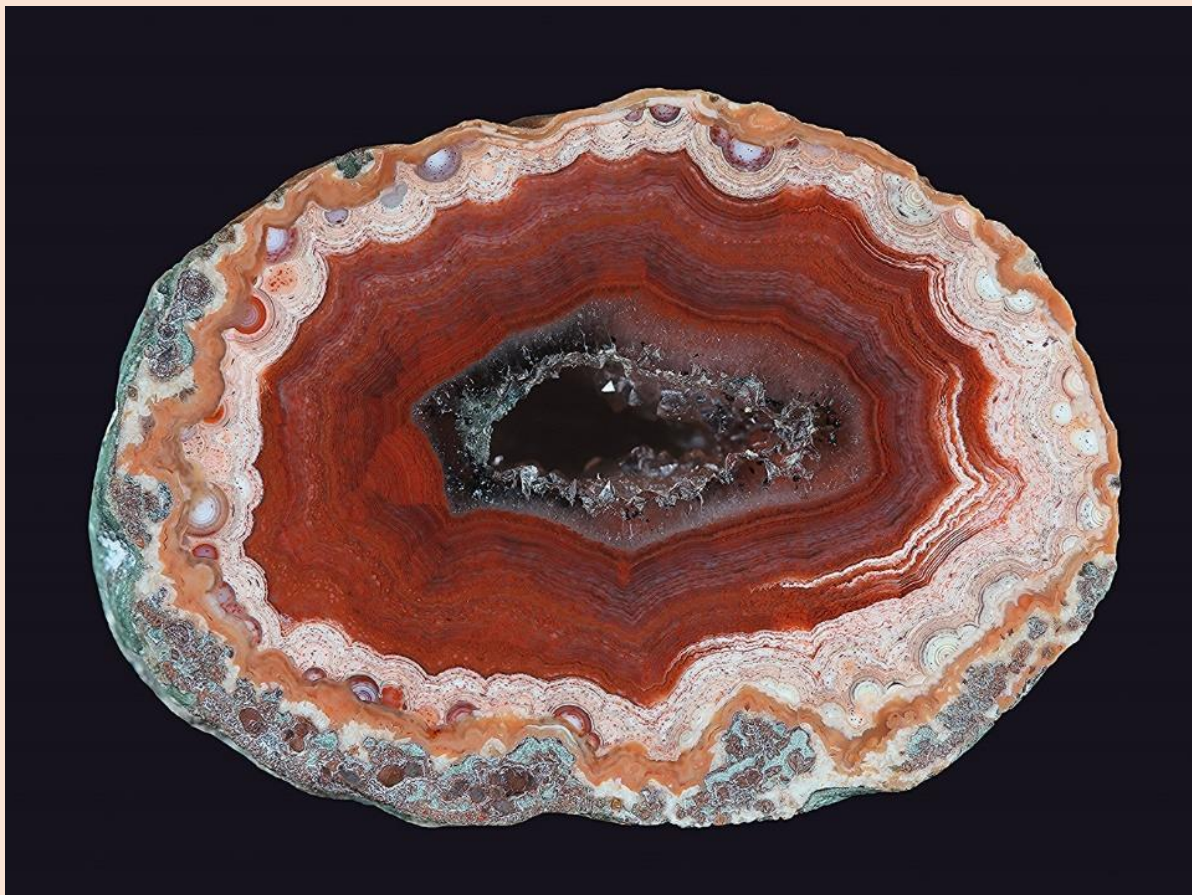

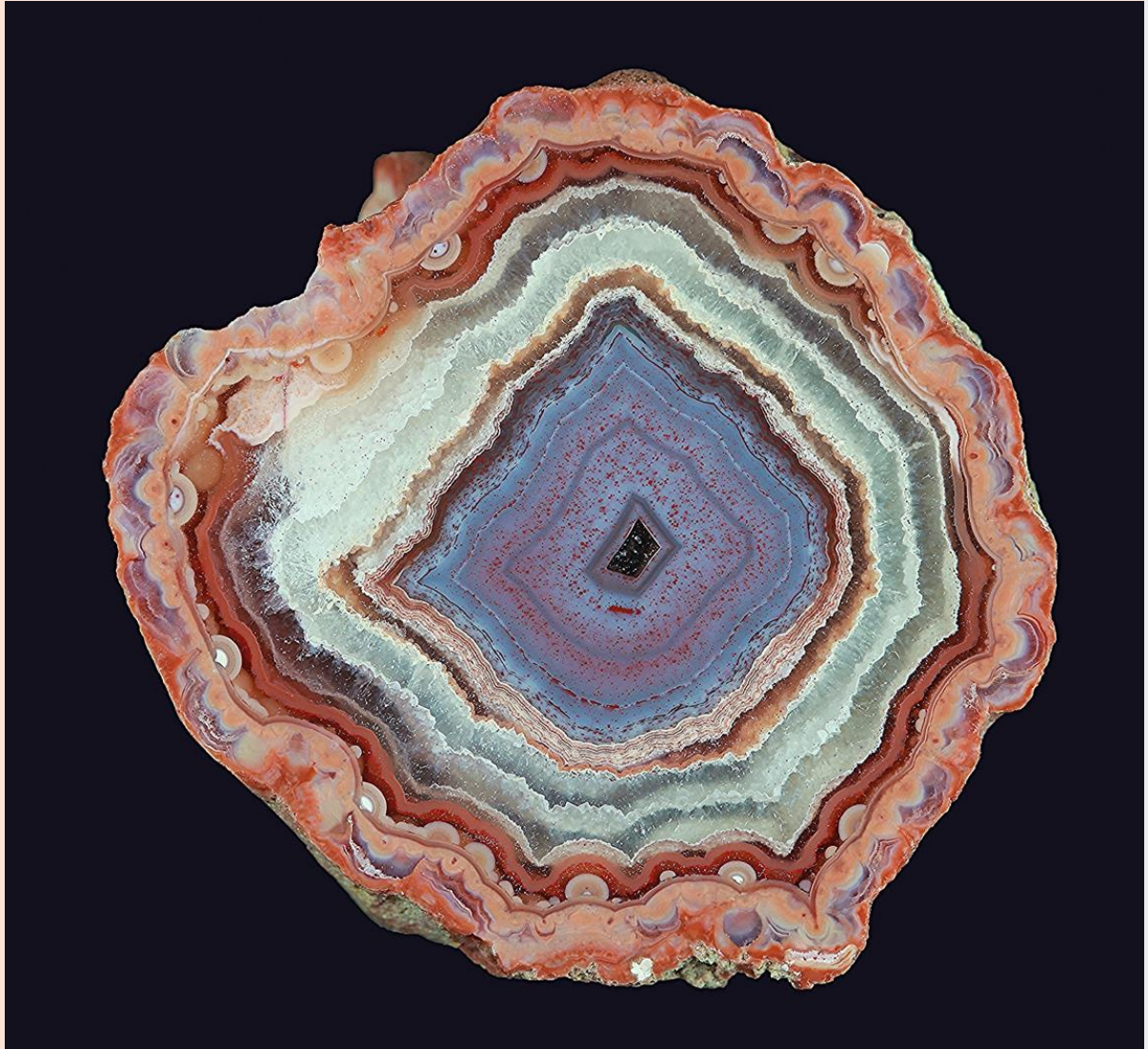

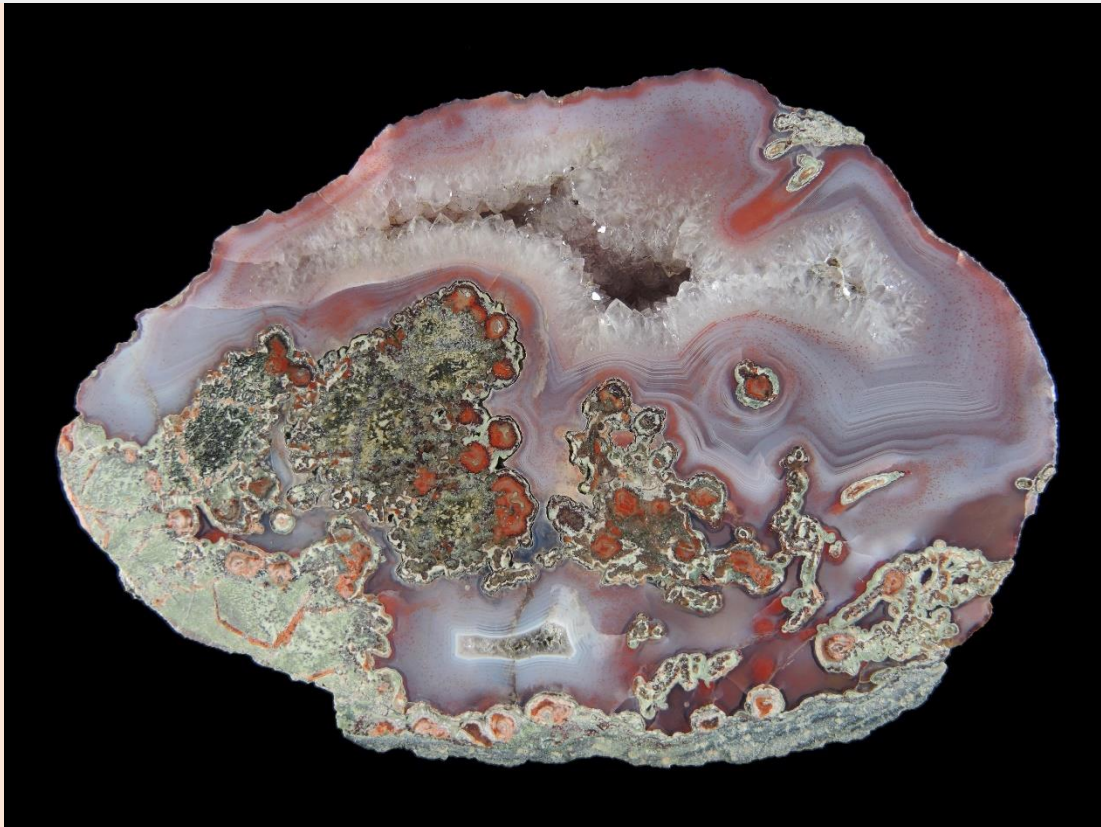

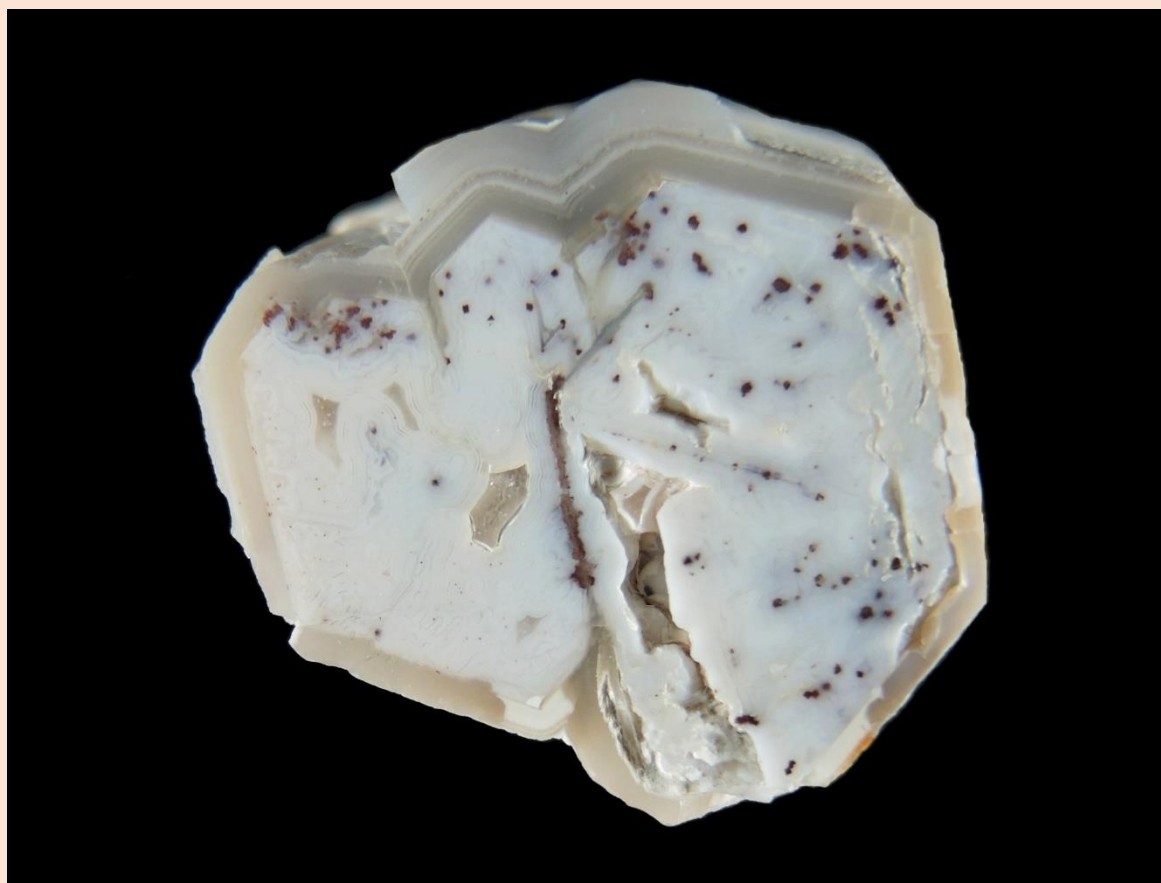

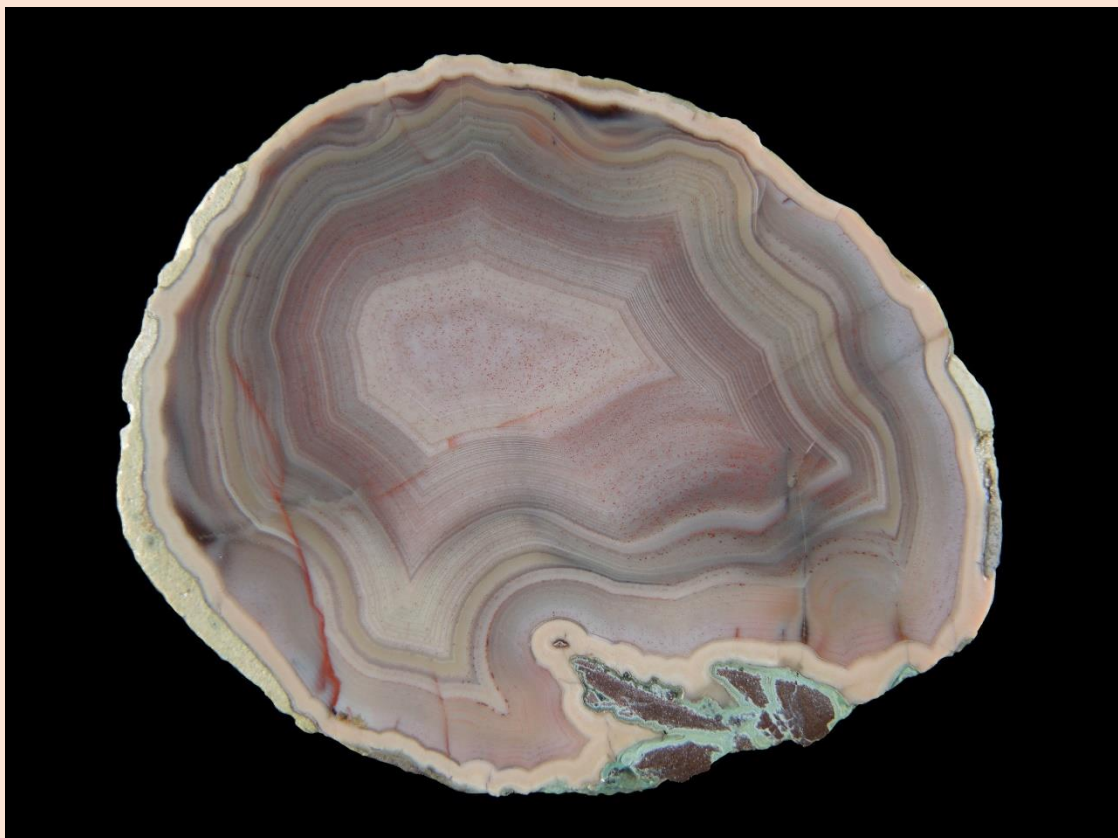
